The Trojan Softball Team was formally started in 2021 and entered the Liverpool League officially in 2022. It was an offshoot from the Trojans Baseball club. The Trojans have won trophies at the last two Liverpool Shields that they have competed in; the Trophy in 2022 and the Spoon in 2023.
