Liverpool League Champions, Sefton Sharks, demonstrated their title credentials in a ruthlessly efficient display against the Liverpool Trojans. Scoring maximum runs in all but one inning, the Sharks won 23-7 in a mercy-rule 5 inning game.

Sharks started in dominant fashion hitting 5 quick runs off Trojans starter, **Peter Smullen**. Smullen who continued his pitching progress with a better strike-ball ratio, encountered a new challenge with his accurate pitching being dispatched by the Sefton offense. In response the Trojans had their usual slow start with the Sharks infield dealing with the first 3 outs for no runs as they struggled to get hold of Sharks' pitcher, **Charlie Whalley.**

The first inning set the tone for the rest of the shortened game although the Liverpool side managed a brief fight back in the 3rd inning with home runs from the impressive Ian Williams, who has shown that he has overcome his injury issues from last year, and Captain David Martin Baez, bringing home 4 runs and holding the Sharks to 3 runs.

That proved to be a mere blip for the Sharks as they stepped things up a notch both in the field with some good catches from the wide-ranging **Meg Bankier**, and continued explosive hitting from throughout their line-up.

Lewis Cranny and Charlie Whalley lead the Sharks' hitting with 2 homeruns apiece. Will Lezick and Chris Jones both also chipped in with 1 dinger each. For the Trojans, Ian Williams had a near perfect batting game going 3 for 3 with two homeruns and, it's not often you can say this, an almost disappointing triple. Mel Byrne went 2 for 3 as well for the Trojans. Sharks MVPs were Cranny and Bankier for their offense and defence respectively, whilst Trojans MVPS were Williams and Di Martin Baez for her improved hitting, reaching base with a good hit and unlucky not to have another.


