The Trojans attack was limited to 2 runs in the first 5 innings, both solo homeruns by Ian Williams and David Martin Baez. Excellent defence by Aly in leftfield and an effective infield wall between second and third base meant that Trojan hitting was generally stifled.

Seagulls attack, whilst initially contained by the improving pitching of Peter Smullen, broke through in the 3rd inning with 5 runs. Despite a pitching change, with Trojan Captain David Martin Baez taking over, Southport managed to score in every inning keeping their score ticking over throughout. With the score at 11-2 at the end of the 5th and the game seemingly out of sight for the Trojans, their offence was sparked into action. 3 runs in the 6th inning was followed by 4 runs in the 7th with bases loaded.

The team from Sowie P held their nerve, having already added 4 runs of their own, getting the last out to secure the relatively straight-forward win.

Stats-wise, 3 hits from rookie Chloe Miossec, Dan Groves and Ian Williams led the Trojans attack. The top Seagulls were father and son duo, Ray and Josh, with 4 hits each, league debutant, Grace, with 3 hits and 2 homeruns from Keith.
